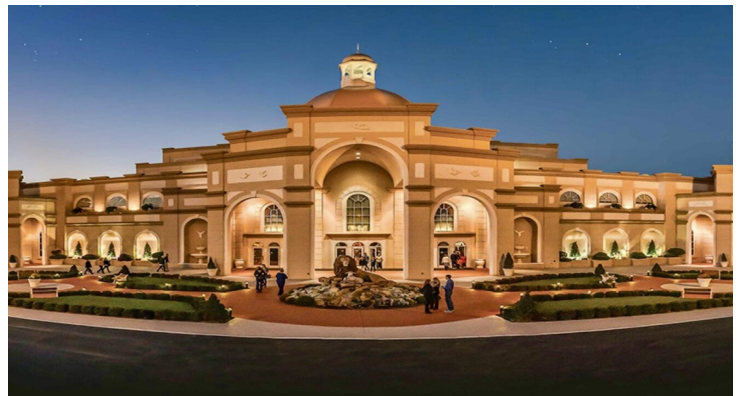
Day One May 27 –

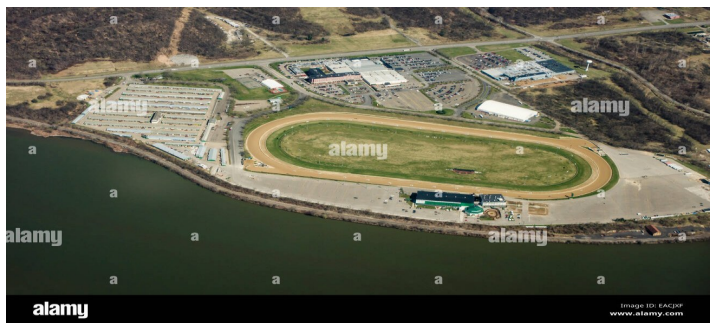

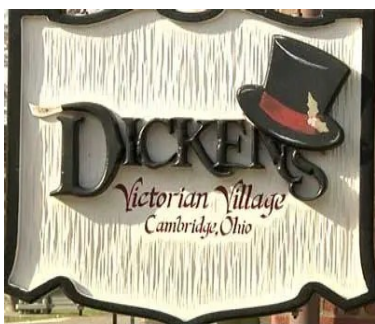
